

2002-03 PARKING INFORMATION

Stickers and Policies

ONLY BLUE AND MAROON STICKERS ARE VALID FOR THE 2002-2003 LEASE TERM.

YOU MUST PICK UP YOUR PARKING STICKER AT THE OFFICE BEFORE WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 4. ANY UNSTICKERED VEHICLES AFTER THAT DATE WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE WITHOUT NOTICE.

CAMPUS HILL APARTMENTS PARKING POLICIES

As per the terms of your lease agreement, parking is not guaranteed. There is off-street parking available at all of our properties for use by Campus Hill residents **only**. Parking is on a first-come/first-served basis.* If the lot is full, it is your responsibility to find legal on-street parking. Please see the guidelines for street parking on the reverse of this form. Campus Hill assumes no responsibility for tickets you may receive as a result of parking illegally.

If you have a car, you must come to the office for a parking sticker with your vehicle registration to verify ownership by you or your parents. It is your responsibility to register your vehicle with Campus Hill and obtain a parking sticker. A phone number is required to obtain a sticker.

Unstickered vehicles are towed away at the owner's expense without notice. Any vehicle, with or without a sticker, that is parked on a lawn, in front of a dumpster or in any other prohibited or illegal location on the property, will be towed without notice at the owner's expense. THIS APPLIES TO TENANTS AND NON-TENANTS ALIKE.

SUMMARY OF PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1. Any unstickered vehicles in any Campus Hill lot will be towed without notice at the owner's expense.**
- 2. Pull all the way into parking spaces** to allow the maximum number of cars to park in the lot. If you must block someone in, you **must** leave a note on your car with the apartment number and/or phone number where you can be reached. **If you cannot be reached, your car will be moved or towed at your expense.**
- 3. Any car, stickered or unstickered, that is parked on a lawn, in front of a dumpster or in any other illegal location, will be towed without notice at the owner's expense.**

Copies of the parking sticker list which includes the sticker, apartment and phone numbers of all tenants, will be available at the rental office by Friday, September 6..

Abiding by these parking rules will help us all avoid many unnecessary inconveniences. Thank you for your cooperation.

* For residents of 200, 212 & 222 Euclid Ave. and 803, 805 Comstock Ave. parking spaces are assigned based on a lottery and will be determined by August 20.

Odd / Even Street Parking - How it works...

Many of you know from last year how congested the parking lots can become. Please keep in mind that the City of Syracuse does allow odd/even street parking in certain areas. There will be signs (white & red) indicating whether on-street parking is allowed in your area.

The odd / even parking regulation within the City of Syracuse reads as follows:

Odd / even parking runs for 24 hours, commencing at 6 PM daily. On an odd date, you park your vehicle on the odd side of the street beginning at 6 PM. (Odd side based on the house numbers example: 208 Comstock Ave is an even side). Continue to use that odd side until 6 PM on the even date, at which time you move your vehicle to the even side of the street. If the end of the month falls on the 31st, you will not need to move your vehicle to the even side of the street until the following day at 6:00PM.

If an emergency vehicle cannot get through, and your vehicle is parked on the wrong side of the street, the city will tow your vehicle immediately.

EXAMPLE...

The signs on the side of the street that our office is on (1201 Harrison Street) reads "Parking permitted from 6 PM odd days to 6 PM even days." This means that from 6 PM of an odd day to 6 PM of an even day, (odd days being the 1, 3, 5, 7 etc.. of the month) you should park on the 1201 Harrison side of the street. At 6 PM on the even day, you should move your vehicle to the other side of the street. For example, if today is Wednesday, August 30, 11 AM, you should park on the side our office is on (odd side) until 6 PM at which time you park on the even side (1208 Harrison side).
